

From the Epistles: James 1: 19-27 (New English Translation, alt) Sharon Purdon

¹⁹ Understand this, my dear brothers and sisters! Let every person be quick to listen, slow to speak, slow to anger. ²⁰ For human anger does not accomplish God's righteousness. ²¹ So put away all filth and evil excess and humbly welcome the message implanted within you, which is able to save your souls. ²² But be sure you live out the message and do not merely listen to it and so deceive yourselves. ²³ For if someone merely listens to the message and does not live it out, they are like someone who gazes at their own face in a mirror. ²⁴ For they gaze at themselves and then go out and immediately forget what sort of person they were. ²⁵ But the one who peers into the perfect law of liberty and fixes their attention there, and does not become a forgetful listener but one who lives it out—they will be blessed in what they do. ²⁶ If someone thinks they are religious yet does not bridle their tongue, and so deceives their heart, their religion is futile. ²⁷ Pure and undefiled religion before God the Father is this: to care for orphans and widows in their adversity and to keep oneself unstained by the world.
